RE: Annual report and 2012 dues statement

Dear Member:

Enclosed please find your 2012 WHAC dues invoice. The 2012 dues are **\$866.00**, which includes applicable sales tax. Again we are offering two payment options. You may pay your dues in full by January 15th or choose to make 3 payments of **\$317.53 by 1/15/12, 2/15/12 and 3/15/12, respectively, which includes a 10% service charge.** *There will be a \$20.00 convenience fee if you are paying by credit card.* You can pay by check or credit card using the form below. A late fee of \$32.50 per month will be added for payments not received by the 15th of each month as an administrative fee to defray WHAC's additional costs incurred in handling late payments.

In 2011, club improvements included: purchase of new pool covers, installation of new pool heater, and installation of new irrigation lines around the volleyball area. Thanks to the efforts of our club manager, Brian Albright, WHAC is successfully operating all of its swim programs in-house and offering yoga instruction as one of its programs.

With the assistance of Dement Harris Design, an Austin-based architectural and land use planning firm, WHAC conducted a member survey in 2011 and adopted a recreation and facility master plan to provide guidance for the club manager and board regarding code compliance and regulations, routine maintenance decisions and potential renovation of facilities or new construction projects. Dement Harris is in the process of completing conceptual plans for construction of a new bath house and ADA-compliant access into and throughout the club. The conceptual plans, when completed, along with the master plan and results of the member survey, will be made available to the membership for review and input before WHAC starts construction of contemplated improvements.

In the interest of safety, risk management and fiscal responsibility, and on the recommendation of WHAC's insurance advisor, the WHAC board of directors recently adopted the Austin Parks and Recreation pool safety guideline concerning unaccompanied minors. Beginning January 1, 2012, each child under the age of 10 at the Rollingwood Pool must be actively supervised by someone (other than club personnel) that is 15 years old or older unless the child is at the pool to participate in a WHAC program, in which event the child will require supervision only before and after their WHAC program time. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in this regard.
